

## Tools Required: (Not included)

- A. Phillips head screwdriver
- B. 10mm open wrench

#### Step 1

Using a Philips screw driver remove the 2 screws on the frame next to the axle bolt.

#### Step 2

Remove one more phillip screw located behind the motor mount plate.



# Step 3

Using a size 10mm open wrench loosen up the nut that holds the tensioner onto the frame and remove it.
