

# Required Tools: (Not included)

A. Long needle pliers

B. 5 mm Allen wrench

#### **AWARNING**

**ACAUTION:** To avoid potential shock or other injury, turn power switch OFF and disconnect charger before performing any assembly or maintenance procedures. Failure to follow these steps in the correct order may cause irreparable damage.


### Step 1

Using long needle pliers, remove the end cap at the back of the brake cable.




### Step 2

Using a 5 mm Allen wrench, loosen the bolt that holds the brake cable onto the brake arm.



## Step 3

Using a 5 mm Allen wrench, loosen and remove the two (2) hex bolts that hold the caliper onto the unit. Slide the caliper out.



## Step 4

To install new brake caliper, reverse steps 1-3.

Attention: Charge battery 6 hours before using
